Parish Posada Journeying with the Holy Family 2018

I invite you to join in with this Advent journey. This is based on the Mexican tradition of a young couple visiting all the houses in a parish re-enacting Mary and Joseph's journey to Bethlehem.

The statue of Mary and Joseph will travel around the parish and stay overnight in different homes throughout Advent.

When the statue arrives at your house, you invite those who bring it to you into your home for hospitality. Please make sure you allow enough time to give and receive the figures and have a conversation and cup of tea (or whatever is offered).



It is important to remember that Advent is a time to make space and not rush around.

There is a short liturgy for you to say as you give and receive the figures. There are also some prayers and Bible references for you to look up and read. How you use these resources is up to you, please feel free to be imaginative. Please also leave a comment or draw a picture in the book provided relating to the visit of the Holy Family to your home. You could also take a photograph of the figure with family and friends or of where you have placed them in your home.

This is a wonderful way for children to think about the journey that Mary and Joseph made before the birth of Jesus. However, this is for people of all ages.

We can all appreciate taking time out of a very busy season to think and pray, looking to the coming of God.

Not everyone will be able to have the statue stay overnight with them, but it may be a nice idea if you invite other church members into your home for coffee whilst the statue is with you.

You will need to take responsibility for contacting the next person on the list to arrange a mutually convenient time to give and receive the statue. (don't leave this until the last minute!)

The statue is fragile, and breakable, so will need to be well cared for and handled by adults.

May you be blessed by this time and in this season of Advent.

come amongst us in all we do.

Help us prepare for your coming
as we journey with Mary and Joseph to Bethlehem.

Prayer & Fellowship Group


At our October meeting we enjoyed a Quiz with twenty miscellaneous questions. The winning pair were Ally and Daphne.
