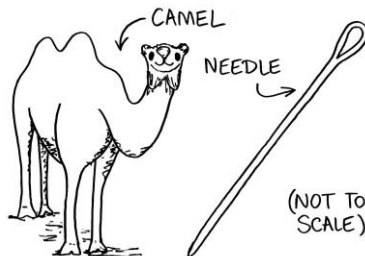
& All Saints, Three Legged Cross
