Above all, we ask that you INSPIRE others to follow you. Be the leader we all need. Share your ideas with friends, on social media groups and make your 2021 resolution to try that little bit harder: to reduce your plastic use, waste in general, and watch the savings mount up!



A moment on the lips, decades on the tip - but your coffee doesn't have to cost the Earth...

Scenes of bins overflowing with coffee cups have sadly become an increasingly usual sight whilst this Tier 2 lockdown endures. None of these coffee cups will be recycled, and despite the masses of resources used in their maufacture they will all go to landfill. It is completely avoidable.

Here's what you can do...



Invest in some reusable cups and get in the habit of always taking them out with you.



If you forget your cup, return your empties to Costa and hand them over - they will recycle them.



Or, take them home, then take them to the recycling centre at Morrisons. These cups can go in the Tetra Pak recycling bin.

Firstly, a massive "Thank you" to our volunteers for all they do to run this facility.

Contamination involving the wrong waste in each bin is our biggest headache. Volunteers have to sort through each bag, remove the contamination, scrunch a massive amount of plastic into a box then post it off to Terracycle.

On the following pages we have listed, for ease of use, what waste you should collect for our current bins.

More importantly, it also details what waste you should MOT put in our bins.

This is vitally important, not only to keep the scheme going but with COVID-19 our volunteers need to handle the minimum amount of packaging possible.

And, if you would like to see a particular recycling bin in our bay, then let us know! But we will need volunteers to manage the bin so have a chat to us about this. Many hands make light work!

ice cream wrappers, non-plastic packaging, foil (Morrisons car park), clear plastic bags, Quality Street wrappers (all compostable!), Smarties tubes (general kerbside recycling!), After Eight sleeves, breakfast/cereal/granola/protein bar wrappers, plastic trays, Ferrero boxes, candy, small Haribo wrappers

NOT ACCEPTED:

plastic bottles/tubs or cardboard (general kerbside recycling), aerosols, toilet fresheners & packaging, oven cleaning packaging, fragrance candles/reeds/plug-ins/autosprays, pump/spray dispensers, cloths/wipes, BABY & TOILET WIPES PACKAGING



Who are they?

Terracycle is "Eliminating the Idea of Waste" by recycling the "non-recyclable".

Through partnering with individual collectors and local groups such as VoW, as well as major companies, retailers and manufacturers, they can collect and recycle almost any form of waste. Across 20 different countries they divert millions of pounds of waste from landfills and incinerators each month.

What happens to the waste?

When challenged with a new type of typically hard-to-recycle waste, the Terracycle research & Development team uses scientific tests to learn how it can be broken down and best reintegrated into the manufacturing supply chain.

Collected waste is deconstructed and sorted by material, then processed into a new "virgin" format that can be sold to manufacturers. For example, plastics are cleaned and melted down, then turned into pellets, flakes and other usable formats that can be moulded into new products and packaging. Find out more at:

WET WIPE WOES



Since introducing our new Home Hygiene and Burt's Bees Make-Up and Personal Care collection bins we have seen lots of packaging for baby wipes and moist toilet tissue.

Whilst its great that people obviously want to find a recycling solution for this waste, unfortunately these schemes cannot currently accept the volume of waste that these wipes present. Whilst some may always "sneak in" we risk our collections being refused if there is a high level of contamination with non-accepted packaging.

As you'll see in the information panels, our bins can currently accept the following:

- Burt's Bees scheme can accept FACIAL WIPES packaging only
- Home Hygiene scheme can only accept HOME CLEANING WIPES

What you can do...

- Contact the companies directly to challenge them on providing a recycling solution for their products and packaging
- Consider switching to a reusable option, kinder to the planet and your pocket!

NOT ACCEPTED:

glass containers, plastic toiletry bottles (general kerbside recycling), BABY & TOILET WIPES

NOT ACCEPTED:

wooden pencils, chalk, glue sticks, erasers, rules or sharp objects (sharpeners, scissors)

What else can be recycled locally, beyond my kerbside collection?

Stretchy plastic

Plastic film, such as used in bread, produce and freezer bags, and protective packaging, can also be recycled with carrier bags at larger supermarkets like Morrisons. Look out for these labels:
